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2019 Holiday Reserve

Zinfandel - Napa Valley

This red wine cuvee by Biale winemaker Tres Goetting is a small lot special selection to share with family and friends as we all celebrate the Holiday Season.

Vintage Notes: A long, warm summer and mild finish to the season. The beginning of the 2019 growing season was defined by copious rainfall and late soil moisture. The long, warm summer saw very few extreme heat events, with foggy mornings setting the stage for vibrant and expressive wines. The long, relatively mild finish to the season, not without its moments of unpredictability, helped to preserve freshness and finesse in the fruit with abundant hang time teasing out great color, structure and soft tannins. Volume is looking to be about average to a little less than average. All in all, exceptional fruit with bright acidity and ample texture promises an amazing vintage.

Harvest Dates: 9-10-19 to 10-12-19

Winemaking: Our winemaking begins in the vineyard with meticulous attention to detail and close monitoring by Bob Biale and winemaker Tres Goetting. The winemaking philosophy is to grow our wines concentrating our efforts all season long in the vineyard so that when the fruit arrives into the cellar, only minimalistic vinification is needed. We want the wines to speak of the soils from which they were grown.

At harvest, the fruit is hand-picked and hand sorted to ensure that only the best fruit makes it into the fermenter. The grapes are then crushed and gravity fed into open top tanks. The must is cold soaked for 2 to 4 days at 50°F. We then inoculate the must with commercial yeast strains. For color and tannin extraction, we do 2 to 3 punch downs per day. Fermentation is usually complete after 14 to 16 days at a maximum temperature of 86°F. At dryness, we lightly press to 100% Burgundy oak barrels of which 40% are new. Malolactic fermentation is completed in the barrels. The wine was aged in barrels for fourteen months.

Alcohol: 14.8%

Blend : 74% Zinfandel, 11% Primitivo, 11% Petite, 1% Alicante, 1% Early Burgundy, 1% Tempranillo, 1% Syrah

Winemaker's Tasting Notes: This unique, one of a kind wine has an old-world core with a new-world flare. Dark color, earthy undertones and juicy acidity with aromas of ripe strawberries, lavender, dried flowers, pear, charcuterie, maple and black cherry. The wine is concentrated yet fresh with a lively entry. The tannins are medium-grained and coat the entire palate. The wine is remarkably balanced with a persistent mouthwatering finish. It is immediately drinkable and worthy of 5 to 15 more years of cellar time.
